The Society shall be responsible for the efficient management and running of the educational institutions entrusted to it from time to time. The society shall be managed by a Board of Governors consisting of 12 Ex officio member and 7 nominated members.

The board of Governors so constituted shall be headed by the Principal Secretary of the Social Welfare Dept. as Chairperson. An officer in the senior time scale of IAS or above shall be appointed as the Chief Executive of the Society and shall also be vested with the powers of Director of a Department for the purpose of operating the budget allocations directly.
